

Purpose of Study Hall: The purpose of Study Hall is to provide a learning environment that is conducive for middle and high school students to work on homework, read or study material for upcoming tests and quizzes. Study Hall is a SILENT work environment. Study Hall is NOT a time for socialization or play.

Expectations of Study Hall

1. Students must sign their name and the time arrived in the Study Hall Log Book.
2. Students may have a snack during study hall.
3. Students must have work to complete, materials to study, or a book to read while in study hall.
4. Students must ask for permission to use a computer for online assignments. A table has been provided for students with laptops computers.
5. A maximum of 3 students will be allowed at each table.
6. Students are not allowed to bring Cell Phones into Study Hall.
7. Students must bring all required textbooks and materials to study hall, as they will NOT be permitted to leave the study hall room once they arrive. Traveling back and fourth from Fellowship Hall will not be allowed.
8. Students must remain in study hall the entire period.
9. Students will not be released from study hall until the period ends, with the exception that a parent comes to study hall and signs a student out. Needed bathroom breaks will be up to the supervisor's discretion. It is strongly suggested, however, that students use the bathroom prior to coming into study hall.
10. Students must show respect to others at all times.
11. Failure to comply with any of the above set policies will result in a loss of privilege to attend study hall.
